

## Day 14

Read: Romans 6:4 then 2 Corinthians 5:17 and then read Colossians 3:10

"NEW" seems to be the key word in each one of these verses. "NEW" lives, "NEW" person and "NEW" nature describe the person who has been re"NEW"ed through the Lord God. Can you say today that you are a "NEW" person? Not only through the salvation that Jesus Christ came to give BUT, "NEW" in every way – speech, actions, thoughts, attitudes, ministry, etc. Spend today through prayer asking God to re"NEW" you in every way.

Close out by reading Colossians 3:11 paying close attention to the last sentence of that verse.

## Day 15

Read: Philippians 1:20-21 then Philippians 2:5-8 and then read Psalm 27:11

"LIVE" seems to be the key word in each one of these verses and in verse 5 of Philippians chapter 2 the word, "ATTITUDE" is key. So here's the question – How does your attitude affect your life? Is your attitude controlled by your Lord God so that you live your life according to His purpose and His calling? Take time today examining your attitude and evaluating your life based on these 3 verses.

## Day 16

Today is a day for prayers for you. As you read the following verses today, make sure you make these your prayers unto the Lord God. Take the time to pray through Psalm 139:23-24. Then take time to pray through Psalm 19:14. Read through Ephesians 1:17-19 and read how the apostle Paul was praying for the people in the church of Ephesus. Make this your prayer unto the Lord as well. Read 3 John 2 and ask the Lord God to give you the strength to make good healthy decisions for your body and good decisions overall for your spirit.

## Day 17

Today is a day for prayers for your family. You just read Ephesians 1:17-19 as a prayer for yourself. Why not do as the Apostle Paul did for the people in the church of Ephesus and pray through these verses as a prayer for your family members. Then read Ephesians 3:16-19 and make these verses a prayer for your

family as well. Speak out names if you feel necessary as you pray this for others. Then read Psalm 1:2-3 and make this your prayer for those in your family as well.

### Day 18

Today is a day for prayers for our nation and our leaders. Read 1 Timothy 2:1-4 and see how God's word encourages you to pray for those in leadership roles. As you read these verses, pray through these verses for the men and women who are leading our nation on a local, state and national level. Literally pray these verses for those who are making decisions that affect your life, your health, your income and your future. Read Philippians 4:8 and pray that our leaders will do what is true, honorable, right, pure, lovely and admirable. Then read Galatians 5:26; Titus 2:11-14 and Romans 8:6 and pray that our leaders will follow as these verses lead.

### DAY 19

Today is a day for prayers for our economy and those people who are without work. You know that many today throughout our nation are hurting when it comes to their financial situation. Our nation's economy has been hurting for a while now. Just take time today to pray for those who are struggling to make their bills, who are struggling to find employment and for those who may feel like all hope is gone. Ask your Lord God how you could be a blessing to someone by helping meet some of their needs at this time in their life. Read Philippians 4:10-17 and read how Paul was so grateful that others were concerned about his situation and some even stepped up to help him in his time of need.

Now pray for contentment in your own personal life as well as the life of many others. Paul said he had learned to be content in NO MATTER what situation he was in. When he had a lot or even when he had little, he had learned to be content. Seems the key to understanding true joy and happiness in any and all situations in your life could be Paul's lesson of being content. Are you? Or are you always looking for the next big and great thing?

### Day 20

Today is a day to pray for your Pastors. Read Psalm 91:1-11 and pray for your Pastors and their protection. Read Psalm 90:12 and pray for their priorities. Ask God to give your pastors the discernment to know the difference between that which is urgent and that which is most important.

Read 1 Peter 1:16 and pray for your Pastors that the Lord God will keep them Holy in every way. Pray for your Pastors and their families. Pray that God would place His angels as guards around their family protecting them and guiding them in His ways.

Read Isaiah chapter 6 and pray that the Lord God would draw your pastors into deep worship of Him. Read Acts 6:1-4 and pray that your pastors would be protected from distractions, unnecessary demands, fatigue, over-commitment and compromise so that they would have time alone with God. Pray as they prepare, preach and pray for the ministry the Lord God has given to them and for the people they lead.

Read Acts 2:37 and pray that God's anointing would be on every word they proclaim. Pray the Lord God will anoint your pastors with the truth.

## Day 21

Today is a day to pray for the ministry of New Vision Church. Today, take time to pray for the potential of new property and building this year for our ministry. Pray for the specific building that we have already placed an offer on that God will guide us in the right path at the right time.

Pray for our ministry opportunities both in our community and around the world. Our ministry in Honduras and our ministry in India. Pray for our preschool, children, student, men's, ladies, family, couples, college, biker, jail, clothes closet, food pantry, music and other ministries that in ALL things and through ALL ministries we will reach ALL people with the message of God's grace and God's love. Pray for each and every one of our weekend Worship Experiences that the spirit of the Lord God will have freedom within the lives and hearts of the people and He will make Himself known. Pray and ask God where is it within the ministry of New Vision you need to be serving for His purposes and His glory.

Don't let this fast be the end but the beginning of what the rest of your life can do for the kingdom of God and His glory. God has something in store for you and He has created and prepared you for such a time as this.

Claim it and allow God to change you by the re"NEW"ing of your mind so that you will never be the same again nor will you settle for the level of life that you have accepted for yourself.

As you close out your 21 Day Fast read Ephesians 3:20 and Philippians 4:13 and Colossians 1:1-23 and CLAIM IT as your life from this day forward and let go of

the past!
